From the West:

From the Intersection of State Route 1 and US Hwy 36 at Chrisman, IL proceed east exactly 3 miles. The farm is on the south side of the road.

From the East:

On US Hwy 36 proceed approximately 5 miles west past the Indiana-Illinois state line. (Approximately one mile west of the Scotland turn off). The farm is on the south side of the road.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. USEF: EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT U.S. EQUESTRIAN RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. The management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary; to combine, divide or limit classes as entries warrant; and to refuse any entry without reason.

2. Health Papers: Negative Coggins dated within 1 year of the show must be submitted for all horses at all shows including schooling shows. Submit a copy with your entries. All equines entering Illinois must be accompanied by the following: 1) Negative test for EIA (Negative Coggins) conducted within 1 year if the animal is more than one year of age; and 2) Certificate of veterinary inspection issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry with a permit number issued by the Illinois Department of Agriculture on the health papers. *IL Diseased Animals Act (510 ILCS 50/1) Violators shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$1,000.*

3. Entries: The enclosed generic entry blank will be the only acceptable entry form for the shows listed in this omnibus. Make copies of the form for each show.

4. Food: Food will be available for purchase on show grounds on all show days.

5. Motorized Vehicle: In accordance with GR901.29: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian (s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

6. Numbers: The horse's competition number must be worn not only while competing, but also while schooling your horse on the grounds.

7. Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted only to fill cancellations.

8. Refunds: Full refund less Office Fee will be made on or before closing date. No entries will be processed unless paid in full. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.**

9. Ride Times: Ride times will be mailed to those competitors who furnish a stamped, self-addressed envelope with their entries OR who furnish an e-mail address.

10. Tests: 2007 USDF Intro and 2007 USEF tests will be used.

11. Arena: All tests will be performed outside in a large (20m x 60m) sand arena. The warm-up areas have dirt or turf footing.

12. Stabling: Limited number of stalls available. Stalls are permanent box stalls with doors. Stabling will be filled on first come basis at \$20 per night.

13. No Dogs Allowed.
